Just how wonderful is it----running across Kingscott Meadow?!




Whom do you meet at the market in December? The Nutcracker !!!!!

Abby smiled her beautiful smile and handed out little plastic bags with homemade cookies.






Everybody got Abby's cookies. Every soldier!
