Van Dyck Court runs into Goya Drive.  
Who is Goya?  
Francisco Goya was a great Spanish Artist.



These boys painted by Goya lived in Spain  
**TWO HUNDRED** years ago.  
They loved books, music, drums, horses,  
birds, cats...  
Just like we do.



Here is a beautiful family portrait of a member of Spanish Royal Family. Mom and Dad with their sons and daughters. The boys playing with toys, a girl leaning against her mother, while the other girl is holding her father's hand.

Imagine sitting or standing in front of the artist who is painting your portrait. Goya was very quick when working on portraits. But it probably still did not feel very quick for the children posing for him.

Here we are walking down Goya Drive and turning on Titian Way.  
Who is Titian?

Titian was one of the most important Italian painters. He was born more than FIVE HUNDRED years ago.

But who is Whistler?

James Abbot McNeil Whistler  
was born in America, studied  
art in Paris, lived in England.



Look, this is Sargent Court.  
Who is Sargent?

John Singer Sargent was born in Italy  
to American parents, educated in  
Germany and France, painted  
in London, New York, or Boston.

Thomas Gainsborough was an English painter. He painted quickly and his portraits are very elegant.

What do you know about Renoir?

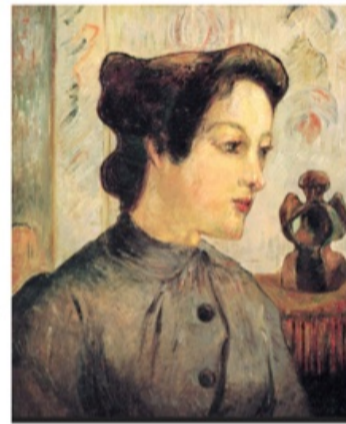


Auguste Renoir was a French artist.

13 years old, and later as a young man, and as an adult...



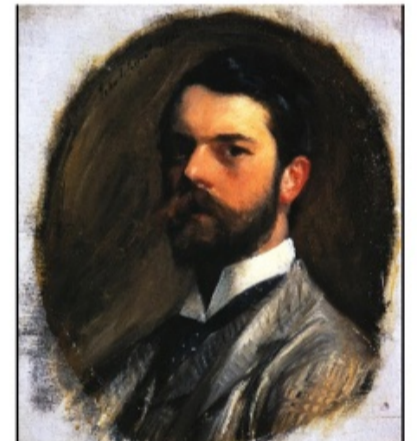

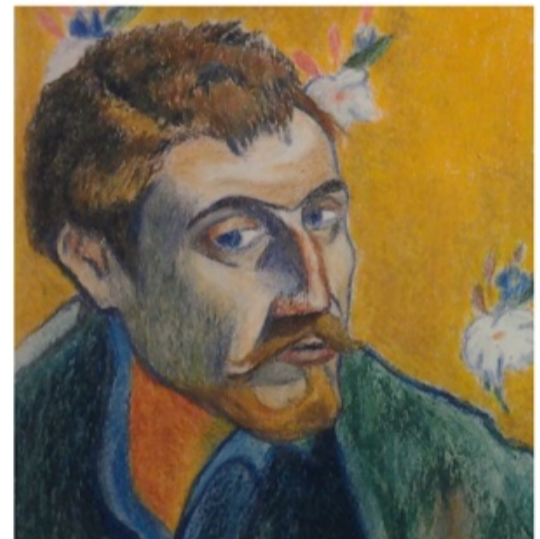
